The materials consisted of two photocopied documents titled "History is a Weapon! Black August Resistance," and "Black August Commemoration: The Revolutionary Class Perspective." While **Underwood** is familiar with the materials, the document has been deemed confidential per CCR Title 15, Section 3321 (a) (2) and 3023 (a). The material will not be returned to **Underwood** in that it contains the Black August materials used in the promotion and training of the BGF representing a direct threat to the safety and security of the institution. The time of the activity is identified as the date of the search on 03/04/08.
